### AWAS PASTEL WORKSHOP: Friday 28th and Saturday 29th March 2025

Our workshop coordinator, Judy Balfour has organized a two-day workshop with tutor Chrissy Murray from Newcastle. She uses both soft pastels and Pan pastels. Chrissy has expert knowledge to impart, and she has a huge following on YouTube, both in Australia and overseas.

For this workshop we will use Pan pastels. (Keep reading you don't need to buy - materials will be supplied).

Please contact me ASAP to show expression of interest. Early payment (also ASAP) ensures your placement in the class.



Cost of the two-day workshop to members is \$180; \$90 deposit by Friday 31<sup>st</sup> January; balance by Friday 28<sup>th</sup> February.

# Chrissy will bring Pan pastels, application tools and papers to use.

They can be used on various surfaces – canvas, any paper with a bit of tooth such as watercolour paper (Hot and Cold Press), even on wood.

Chrissy works at Soft Pastels Australia <u>www.softpastels.com.au</u> and she will bring some equipment to sell – if you are interested – no pressure!

Pan pastels can be used for under painting, and we will do some mixed media with this technique e.g. using coloured pencils on top. A few AWAS members have Pan pastels and are willing to share. Our member, Cathie Waller, uses Pan pastels, and you may have seen her work hanging at the studio and the Plant Farm. If you Google Pan pastels and you will find a wealth of information and demonstrations.
